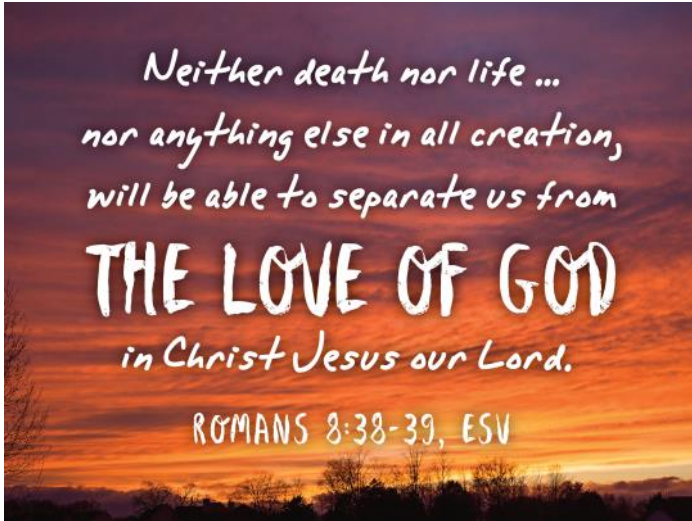


Welcome
